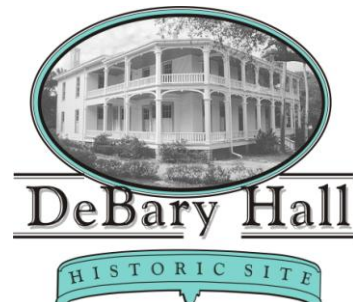

An ECHO Ranger is a child in grades 1 - 5 who understands and appreciates the unique learning adventures of the ECHO (Ecological, Cultural, Heritage and Outdoors) offerings in Volusia County.

The benefits of this program include fun, learning, appreciating Volusia County's ECHO assets, and spending quality time with family.

Each ECHO Ranger chooses at least eight of the sites to complete an ECHO Ranger activity. The sites have different times and dates for activities. Students must complete a minimum of eight activities to graduate from the program in June.

Participants must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

A \$20 registration fee, per child, includes:

- Admission to participating sites for the ECHO Ranger candidate and one adult
- ECHO Ranger ID badge with lanyard
- Official ECHO Ranger "Passport to Adventure" guidebook
- An ECHO Ranger T-shirt
- Admission to the graduation picnic on June 9, 2012
